

Henry County SPLOST Breaks Ground for Intersection Improvements to Old Conyers and Flat Rock Roads

The Henry County Board of Commissioners, together with the SPLOST Department, recently broke ground on intersection improvements to Old Conyers Road and Flat Rock Road, with the intention of improving the flow of traffic and avoiding traffic backups, particularly during peak school hours.

The improvements will consist of right and left turning lanes, as well as a traffic light with turn signals. Nine bids were received and the project was awarded to the lowest bidder, E.R. Snell Construction, in the amount of \$987,600.

“This new intersection improvement is going to be a tremendous help for both districts four and five with the added turn lanes and traffic signal. It will be a huge safety benefit plus it will move traffic along very smoothly,” said District IV Commissioner Reid Bowman.
